The Prayer Shawl ministry began just over one year ago. To date, somewhere in the neighborhood of 85 shawls have been

consecrated, and over 50 have been given out. The criteria for who receives the shawls were discussed at our Council on Ministries before the ministry began. It

was deemed to someone in need, whether by physical ailment, grief or just in a difficult period of life. Our prayer shawl group has already begun meeting, but always welcomes more. At present, the group will meet once a month, in the overflow area behind the Sanctuary on the 3rd Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM. Group members DO NOT need to knit or crochet to belong. There are many other ways to be active in this ministry... balling yarn, cutting and/or attaching fringe, checking yard sales for more yarn, preparing the shawls for consecration and then removal from the altar afterward for packaging.
